### About the Scholarship Awards and Eligibility:

- Our Council intends to award two scholarships, with a combined total of several thousand dollars, to be applied to the first year of tuition at any Catholic high school. *Our Council reserves the right to award additional scholarships if there are available funds and quality of applications justify additional awards.*
- Each scholarship is a one-year award.
- Awards are given only to parishioners of Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church, with the primary focus of the awards being given to those who put into practice their Catholic faith and values in their daily actions and interactions with others.
- Interested individuals must submit this application (**deadline is Tuesday, April 25**).
- The Council will invite finalists for interviews in mid- to late-May.
- Awards will be announced on Monday, June 5, 2017.
