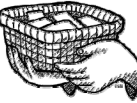
OFFERING

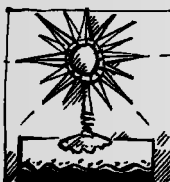

On all Fridays in Lent, Benediction and Reposition will begin at 6:30 pm.

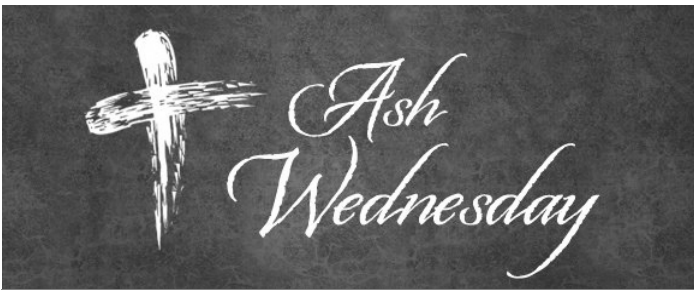

FAST and ABSTINENCE

The norms, according to the USCCB:

Everyone, age 14 and over, is bound to obey the law of abstinence from eating meat. Abstinence is to be observed on all Fridays within the season of Lent.

On **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**, everyone over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year is also bound to observe the law of fast. On these two days only one full meatless meal is allowed.

Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, therefore, are the only days of both fast and abstinence.

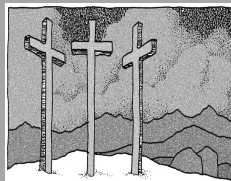
