FAST and ABSTINENCE ~

The norms, according to the USCCB:

Everyone, age 14 and over, is bound to obey the law of abstinence from eating meat.

Abstinence is to be observed on

all Fridays within the season of Lent.

On **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**, everyone over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year is also bound to observe the law of **fast**.

On these two days only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, therefore, are the only days of <u>both</u> fast and abstinence.

As we enter into this Holy Year proclaimed by Pope Francis, we are called to be "Pilgrims of Hope." This coming year brings us so many graces and opportunities for us to grow in our faith an to do our part to build up God's Kingdom.

We are especially being called to practice the Corporal and Spiritual Acts of Mercy. One of the Corporal Acts is to bury the dead. We know that all of us will one day be called home to the Lord. During our journey here on earth we experience the deaths of those we love and share our life with. We grieve and mourn for our loss, but we rejoice in the eternal life which will be theirs.

Our parish needs your help so that we can reach out to those who have experienced the death of a loved one - to give comfort and support them during a time of sadness and grief. Would you please consider becoming a member of one of our Blessed Sacrament Funeral Teams? This spiritual work would be open to adult men and women of our parish. The teams help set up the church for the Funeral Mass, greets the family and other mourners, act as hospitality ushers, and guides the readers and gift bearers who will be taking part in the celebration of the Funeral Mass.


