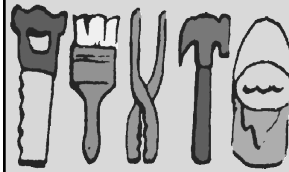
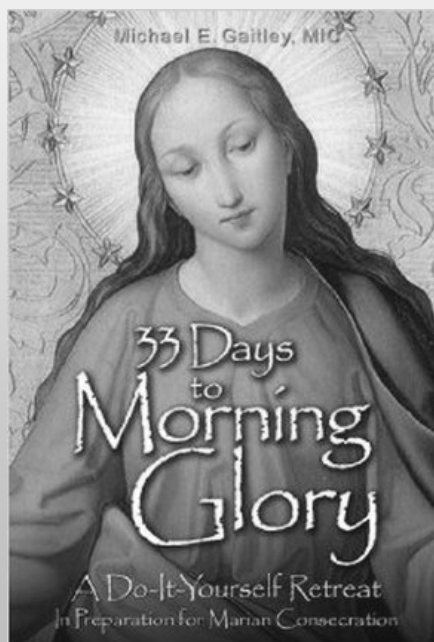
Our weekly "retreat" meetings are scheduled to prepare participating souls for a May 13 consecration.

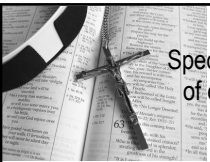
